The club is equipped with its own lathe, audio and video system with two monitors, in order that everyone can clearly see the turning process. The club is fully insured through the Association of Woodturners of Great Britain, to whom we are affiliated.

Meetings usually take the form of a demonstration, most often by a professional woodturner, but sometimes by one of the more experienced club members. The opportunity exists for questions to the demonstrator, but in addition with the spirit of camaraderie that exists among members, help and advice for those who are new to the craft can always be obtained from the more experienced turners.

Should you have doubts as to whether the club is right for you, the arrangement exists where it is possible to attend up to three meetings at a nominal cost of £3.00 per meeting without any commitment to join.
